## SAT/CLASS RANK

- 1007 average SAT score (Critical Reading & Math scores) of baccalaureate seeking freshmen 2010 group.
- 8% of freshmen class graduated in top 10% of their high school class; 31% in top quarter of class

83% of first year students and 49% of all undergraduates live in the residence halls.
