

HEA STUDENT CONSUMER INFORMATION

Disclosure Requirements on Student Diversity

Institutions must make available to current and prospective students information about student body diversity, including the percentage of enrolled, full-time students in the following categories:

- Federal Pell Grant recipients
- Male
- Female
- Self-identified members of a major racial or ethnic group

For the 2019-2020 academic year, 56% of first-time full-time undergraduates and 47% of all undergraduates received Pell Grants.

Undergraduates must carry 12 or more credits to be considered full-time, while graduate students must carry nine or more credits. Mansfield's enrolled **1,386** full-time undergraduates and no full-time graduate students for **fall 2021**.
