An Exhibition of Regional High School Art Teachers and their Students

April 4 - 28, 2022

Loomis Gallery is pleased to announce another year of the Master & Grasshopper Exhibition for local art teachers and their students! The exhibition will be in the physical gallery and open to the public for viewing Monday-Friday, 8 am -4 pm.

Artwork will also be displayed online as well.

Submission Deadline:

Extended to Friday, March 21, 2022

Drop-off of Artwork:

Friday, April 1, 3 - 8 pm Saturday, April 2, 9 am - Noon

Artwork Pick-up:

Friday, April 29, 3 - 8 pm Saturday, April 30, 9 am - Noon



Art teachers never stop being artists, but at times the daily rigors of teaching can outweigh the opportunity to show their own work. We present an opportunity for the teacher and the student to show their work together. The pieces do not need to be collaborative or of the same genre, though that certainly would be acceptable. We know that you, their art mentor, know your students best. This is why we are contacting you directly! Unfortunately, space is limited so we are leaving it up to you to decide which one or two of your students to join you in the exhibition.

General Requirements: A high school art teacher and one or two of their students (9-12 grade) within the region of PA and NY. Student artwork should be representative of a class project which the teacher assigned. More than one teacher may apply from a school.

Additional Participant Commentary: In showcasing the Master and Grasshopper exhibition, we would like to include additional commentary both from the student's and teacher's points of view:

- **Teachers:** In no more than two paragraphs, please describe your decision-making process in choosing the selected student(s) for the show. Also, please include a brief artist's statement.
- **Students:** In no more than two paragraphs, please describe how you have benefited from the art classes you have taken under your teacher's guidance, as well as a brief artist's statement.

Artwork Requirements: Mediums represented may be of any genre from all entrants and do not have to be similar in theme. All artwork must be ready for presentation and able to be hung or displayed. Twodimensional works must be matted and wrapped at a minimum, preferably framed with hanging wire. Paintings should be presentable (sides painted at a minimum), preferably framed with a hanging wire. Artworks must not exceed 3.5 ft. in any direction including frame. 3D artwork is welcome! Please only submit one artwork per person in your submissions unless it is a diptych, triptych, or set in the case of 3D.

Awards: There will be four prize awards given to the students, decided by a juror*.

- Best in Show
- First Place
- Second Place
- Third Place
- Honorable Mentions

^{*} It is our intention to accept all entries that have completed the proper submission paperwork. In case of an extremely large amount of submissions, the juror will also select works to be included in the exhibition



Entry Fee: There will be a \$15 entry fee per teacher made payable to C.C.S.I.

Submissions: Please submit one photo for 2D artwork and up to 3 photos for each 3D artwork (different views) to kcobb@mansfield.edu. Files should be in .jpeg format and at 300 dpi. Please submit images of good quality for these are the images used in the online component.

Image and statement submissions must be received by March 21, 2022, through email to kcobb@mansfield.edu. Awards will be juried from digital submissions and will be used for online content, so please try to have good-quality images.

Artists will be notified by March 28, 2022, to confirm acceptance into the exhibition. Acceptance will be based on the total number of entries.



Sales Commission: If an artwork sells during the exhibition, Loomis Gallery receives 20% of the selling cost as gallery commission. Please price artwork to represent the 20% commission. If not for sale, please label NFS, but also list a value price for insurance purposes while the artwork is in the exhibition.

Delivery: Participants must deliver artwork to the Loomis Gallery on/by the following dates:

- Friday, April 1, 3-8 pm or
- Saturday, April 2, 9 am-Noon
- -Two-Dimensional Artwork must be ready to hang.
- -All pieces must include completed labels (located on the last page of this form).
- -In-person drop-off is preferred but I understand many come from a long-distance away, so shipping of artwork is allowed.
- -Shipping is allowed. All shipments must be accompanied by a pre-paid, insured, return shipping label. If you decide to ship, please make sure the artwork will arrive before April 1. I may recommend using Fed Ex or UPS. Last year there were many late entries due to USPS issues. Please pack artwork properly with bubble wrap to protect during the shipping process. Loomis Gallery is not responsible for any damage that occurs during shipping.


