Minimum Degree Requirements (120 total credits)

- Please refer to online General Education requirements for details.
- All PASSHE Bachelor of Arts students must either complete two years (four semesters) of a foreign language or declare a minor.
- Within the same Gen Ed category, such as Humanities, the same prefix may not be used twice.

- Students must complete at least one laboratory course in the Natural Sciences group.
- Upper Division Requirement: take 48 credits at the Upper Division level.
- A maximum of 67 credits are transferable from two-year institutions.
- 50% of major credits must be completed at Mansfield University.
- 25% of overall degree credits must be completed at Mansfield University.
